**Postgraduate**

If you are studying a Professional Graduate Diploma in Education (PGDE) full-time, the funding arrangements will be the same as for a full-time undergraduate course. You should go back to the undergraduate section for full details.

As of the 2017-2018 academic session, Postgraduate applications are now completed and submitted using our new online services. This applies to students studying full time and part time.

If you have never applied to us for funding before, you should click [My Account](#) and register your details. You will then be given the option to submit an application for funding.

If you have applied to us before, you will need to click [My Account](#) and register on our new online services. Once registered you can complete and submit an application for funding.

You should ensure that you select Postgraduate as your course type on the 'Course Information' page.

In addition to applying for your funding, you will also be able to check the status of your application, view your award notice and maintain the details we hold for you by using the services within your online account.

If you have forgotten your password and/or email address and cannot access your online account, you can use our "forgotten your email address/password" services by clicking on [My Account](#).

**Full-time student**

This section provides information on the funding available to eligible full-time students who are studying one of the three course types described below. You will also find details here of how to apply for your funding.

The **undergraduate** area provides information on the funding available to eligible students who are on full-time HNC, HND, degree, PGDE or equivalent courses.

The **Nursing/midwifery** section explains the funding available for eligible students who are taking full-time courses in pre-registration nursing or midwifery. This includes students who are on a diploma course in nursing or midwifery or on an honours degree course in nursing or midwifery.

The **Postgraduate** option will give you details of the funding available for a full-time postgraduate course of professional or vocational training, mostly at diploma level.

- You have not supported yourself from earnings or benefits outside full-time education for any three years before the first day of the first academic year of your course.
- You are not married, in a civil partnership or living with a partner before the first day of the first academic year of your course. We will review this if your circumstances change during your course.

If any of the above statements do not apply to you, you should go to the **Independent student** area.
